

Student's Bill of Rights

A society cannot consider itself "just" or "humane", when ANY human beings are mistreated, especially those who are powerless.

Students are human beings

- 1) Students have the right to be free from threats and intimidation by adults, including using punishment to obtain obedience and compliance.
- 2) Students have the right to be free from verbal or physical abuse by adults, including raised voices or derogatory remarks.
- 3) Students have the right to privacy, including no one being allowed to search their belongings or electronic devices without their permission.
- 4) Students have the right to their property, including no one being allowed to seize any property belonging to the student without the student's permission.
- 5) Students have the right to use the toilet whenever they deem necessary, without having to obtain "permission".
- 6) Students have the right to drink when they are thirsty, and eat when they are hungry.
- 7) Students have the right to dress as they see fit, including deciding whether or not to use the "school uniform".
- 8) Students have the right to be treated respectfully at all times.
- 9) Students have the right to sit where, and with whom, they choose.
- 10) Students have the right to be free from arbitrary regimentation for no purpose other than the exercise of authority and power.
